- 1 The Commission's 26th Supplemental Order established a Part D schedule for filing of testimony. Parties agreed to file Direct, Response, and Reply Testimony on November 7, 2001, December 20, 2001, and January 29, 2002, respectively.
- 2 On November 30, 2001, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed a motion for leave to file supplemental direct testimony and exhibits. Some cost studies were not completed on the initial date for filing direct testimony, and some costs were inadvertently omitted from a study that was timely filed.
- 3 Qwest's late-filed testimony and exhibits are relevant to the pending issues in this proceeding. Qwest's request is granted.
- 4 However, it is necessary to amend the schedule for filing response and reply testimony in order to avoid prejudice to other parties. The schedule for filing testimony and exhibits is amended as follows:

Response Testimony	December 20, 2001
Supplemental Response Testimony	January 11, 2002
Reply Testimony	January 29, 2002
Supplemental Reply Testimony	February 5, 2002

- 5 Parties requiring additional time to file Response or Reply Testimony must file a request stating good cause in advance of the due date.
