Pursuant to the procedural order issued as Order-03, and as reiterated during the hearings held on September 21 and September 30, 2022, Post-Hearing Briefs are due to be filed today, October 21, 2022. This letter is to notify the Commission, Administrative Law Judge O'Connell and all parties to this docket that Walmart will not be filing a Post Hearing Brief. Walmart is a signatory to the Full Multiparty Settlement Stipulation and the Colstrip Tracker Stipulation. Walmart filed Joint Testimony in Support of the Full Multiparty Settlement Stipulation on July 8, 2022, and Supplemental Joint Testimony in Support of the Colstrip Tracker and Tariff Schedule 99 on July 29, 2022. Walmart appeared at the hearing in support of these settlement stipulations on September 21, 2022, and at the continued hearing on September 30, 2022. Walmart has nothing to add to its position and will therefore not be filing a Post-Hearing Brief.
