## **QWEST DATA REQUEST NO. 21:**

Please provide all documents pertaining to the Staff's estimate that it would cost Qwest \$150,000 to extend service to the occupants of the Timm Ranch.

## **RESPONSE:**

There are no documents. Staff estimated that the cost per mile would be approximately \$20,000. The reasonableness of the estimate of \$150,000, made in Staff's Open Meeting Memo (January 9, 2002), is confirmed by Testimony of Mr. Spinks in April. He stated: "The Timm Ranch buried cable line extension construction cost is estimated at \$29,383 which is actually less than the historical cost of placing buried facilities. The historic cost for aerial plant has been \$25,805 per mile while the Nelson aerial line extension cost is estimated at \$19,402 per mile which again, is significantly lower than the historic cost." Unless Qwest's costs are substantially higher than those of Verizon, applying the estimate to Qwest in January, as Staff also did to Verizon, was reasonable.
