1 Westgate Communications LLC d/b/a WeavTel requests extension of the current
agreement reached between the WUTC and Westgate on January 30th, 2007 on the above
docket numbers.

2 Westgate further requests extension of the time to file a new Revenue requirement
objective.

3 The Agreement between the WUTC and Westgate is due to expire on June 30th 2008,
and Westgate requests it be extended until February 28th 2009 to allow time for a new
WCAP Revenue Objective to be filed. As discussed with staff members of the WUTC, this
time is needed to gather Traffic Studies that will reflect a more accurate representation of
actual traffic at a more active time period. This time is also needed to complete audited
financials for the year of 2007.

4 Through many delays, beyond Westgate's control, Westgate obtained the facilities to begin collecting its traffic data in late October 2007. Westgate is requesting an extension of time to file its revenue requirement so that its study can be based on a complete year of traffic to accommodate the influx of seasonal traffic.


5 Westgate is currently collecting data for the traffic studies and audits are being performed. The audits and traffic studies will be completed in the time frame that Westgate has requested extensions for.

6 This extension should be approved to allow Westgate to present a more complete and permanent Revenue Requirement and present audited financials
