I. INTRODUCTION

DTG Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a DTG Recycle ("DTG") seeks to withdraw its solid waste application related to e-waste, which was filed on August 5, 2024, and updated on August 27, 2024. Staff does not object to DTG's Motion to Withdraw.

If DTG reevaluates the scope of its proposed services and refiles, the inquiry could be more focused. Withdrawing the filing now does not appear to prejudice any party.
