AMENDED REQUEST OF VERIZON NORTHWEST INC. FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF INFORMATION

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-160, Verizon Northwest Inc. ("Verizon NW") hereby requests confidential treatment of the following materials that Verizon NW filed yesterday: (1) pages 10-12, 75, 89-90, and 92 of the Rebuttal Testimony of James H. Vander Weide; (2) exhibits RRP-2C, RRP-4C, and RRP-5C to the Rebuttal Panel Testimony.

All of these materials are either competitively sensitive to Verizon NW and its vendors or have been deemed proprietary by AT&T, pursuant to the Protective Order in this proceeding. *See* First Supplemental Order, Docket UT-023003 (March 22, 2003). Specifically, pages 10-12, 75, 89-90, and 92 of the Rebuttal Testimony of James H. Vander Weide contains information regarding the cost of capital that AT&T uses to evaluate local exchange investments. This information was provided by AT&T in

response to a Verizon NW discovery request and was deemed confidential by AT&T. Exhibits RRP-2C, RRP-4C, and RRP-5C to the Rebuttal Panel Testimony contain Verizon engineering guidelines and backup workpapers supporting the demand and cost quantities for Verizon's network, which are competitively sensitive to Verizon.

Verizon NW has followed the procedures specified in WAC 480-07-160 and the Protective Order for the marking and service of the proprietary versions of these materials. In addition, and in accordance with WAC 480-07-160, Verizon NW has submitted redacted versions of the materials containing proprietary information. Verizon NW therefore requests that the designated information be treated confidential.
