4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is L. Edward Odom. My business address is 10885 NE Fourth Street,

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as Director, Thermal
9 Resources.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Director, Thermal Resources?**

11 A. As Director, Thermal Resources I plan, organize, and direct PSE's gas and coal
12 electric energy production, including operations, maintenance and modernization
13 of the project facilities. Additionally, I manage all thermal purchased power
14 agreements for PSE.

15 **Q. Briefly describe your training and relevant employment experience.**

16 A. I have over 30 years of experience in the electric utility, construction and
17 rehabilitation industry with specific expertise in utility management, engineering,
18 project management, construction, operations and maintenance. Prior to joining

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PSE in June 2007, I was Executive Manager of Generation for Chelan County Public Utility District in Wenatchee, Washington. As such, I was responsible for planning, organizing and directing the Generation Business Unit, which included capital improvement projects, hydroelectric project relicensing, and operation and maintenance of the District's generating assets. At Chelan County Public Utility District, I was also responsible for the management of the Rocky Reach Hydroelectric Rehabilitation Project, Rocky Reach Juvenile Fish Bypass Project and the Rock Island Modernization Project.

Prior to joining Chelan County Public Utility District, I was Plant Manager of the Goldendale Energy Center and Maintenance Supervisor/Power Plant Engineer for the Calpine Corporation in San Jose, California. I also worked for over 13 years as an engineer for Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation in Denver, Colorado.
