### **REQUEST:**

Has Avista performed a cost of service study showing parity ratios for customer classes since the RY2 rates from Docket UE-220053 went into effect? If so, please provide these parity ratios and all supporting workpapers. If not, please perform such a study or provide the data necessary to perform such a study.

#### **RESPONSE:**

No. Avista has not performed an updated cost of service study with RY2 rates from Docket UE-220053 went into effect, as the settlement and final Order per Docket UE-220053 was results oriented, and therefore we are unable to functionalize the revenue requirement at the level of detail necessary to update the study.
