ALLIANCE OF WESTERN ENERGY CONSUMERS' REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF PACIFICORP CUSTOMER REPRESENTATION SUB-FUND GRANT

Pursuant to Article 7.1 of the Washington Extended Interim Participatory Funding Agreement ("Extended IPFA") approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") in Order 02¹ in Docket U-210595, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers ("AWEC") hereby requests final payment of AWEC's PacifiCorp Customer Representation Sub-Fund Grant in the amount of \$36,000.00. On December 30, 2021, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company ("PacifiCorp" or the "Company") filed its Final Clean Energy Implementation Plan as required

by the Commission's rules implementing the Clean Energy Transformation Act ("CETA").

On May 25, 2022, as required by Article 6.2 of the initial Interim Participatory Funding Agreement ("IPFA"), AWEC filed its request for Case Certification and Notice of

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Intent to Request a Fund Grant, which was also served on the Company and all parties of record in the proceeding. In that filing, AWEC identified the PacifiCorp Customer Representation Sub-Fund as the account from which AWEC intended to request a Fund Grant. AWEC subsequently submitted a budget of \$10,000 for the proceeding.

On December 8, 2023, AWEC filed a Request for Payment of \$8,390.60, which the Commission approved by Order 08 on January 26, 2024.

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5 On November 1, 2023, PacifiCorp filed its 2024-2025 Biennial Clean Energy Implementation Plan Update ("Biennial Update"). At its March 25, 2024, Open Meeting, the Commission suspended this matter and set it for adjudication.

On May 23, 2024, AWEC filed a Proposed Budget under the Extended IPFA with the Commission, requesting a Fund Grant of \$36,000.00 from the PacifiCorp Customer Representation Sub-Fund to partially offset the costs of AWEC's review of the Biennial Update. On June 4, 2024, AWEC's Proposed Budget was approved by the Commission in Order 14 in the full amount of \$36,000.00.

Pursuant to Section 9.3 of the Extended IPFA, "[t]ermination of this [Extended IPFA] (under this Section or at the end of the Term of this [Extended IPFA]) shall not discharge or relieve any Party from any obligations or liabilities which may have accrued under the terms of this [IPFA] before such termination. In particular, the Commission shall require the Participating Public Utility or Utilities to pay Eligible Expenses incurred under a Commissionauthorized Fund Grant that was awarded before the date of termination, subject to satisfaction of the requirements in Article 7." As shown in Confidential Exhibit A, AWEC incurred \$36,000 in

Accordingly, while the Extended IPFA terminated on December 31, 2024, AWEC is entitled to reimbursement of its Eligible Expenses incurred under its Commission-authorized Fund Grant, provided that AWEC has satisfied the requirements of Article 7 of the Extended IPFA.

At this time, AWEC requests that the Commission authorize final payment of AWEC's approved Sub-Fund Grant in the amount of \$36,000.00 from the 2024 PacifiCorp Customer Representation Sub-Fund. This Request for Payment satisfies the requirements of the Extended IPFA as follows:

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<u>Article 7.1(a)</u> – The itemized expenses, payees, and hourly rates – including separately identified amounts for consultant or expert witness fees and travel expenses – are attached as Confidential Exhibit A.

<u>Article 7.1(b)</u> – AWEC has been an active participant in this Proceeding. AWEC reviewed the filings in this Proceeding, conducted discovery, filed testimony, participated in settlement discussions, participated in the evidentiary hearing, and filed two briefs. The expenses included in Confidential Exhibit A are reasonable and directly attributable to AWEC's participation in Docket UE-210829. <u>Article 7.1(c)</u> – As set forth in this Request for Payment, AWEC has provided information sufficient to demonstrate that AWEC has complied with all conditions and requirements of its approved Sub-Fund Grant.

<u>Article 7.1(d)</u> – This Request for Payment constitutes a Request for Final Payment for the full amount of AWEC's approved budget in this Proceeding.
