1 Household Goods Permit No. HG-60567 stands in the name of Britin, Inc., and authorizes the services therein set forth.

2 On April 30, 2004, Docket No. TV-032074 was issued suspending Household Goods Permit No. HG-60567 for failure to file acceptable proof of liability and property damage insurance with this Commission.

3 Mr. Smith has requested that Permit No. HG-60567 be further suspended. Mr. Smith is currently seeking reinstatement of his insurance policy and has requested additional time.

4 The Commission having reviewed the circumstances and being fully advised of the facts and noting that Britin, Inc., will not be operating vehicles under his Household Goods permit authority, is of the opinion that it would not be detrimental to the interest of the public to further suspend Household Goods permit HG-60567 until July 14, 2004.

ORDER

5 Therefore, this order further suspends Household Goods Permit No. HG-60567. As the certificate is suspended, the holder is directed to cease all operations associated with this permit. To avoid cancellation, the certificate holder must file acceptable proof of insurance or request a hearing by July 14, 2004 to show why the certificate should not be canceled.
