- On September 2, 2004, Heckman Motors, Inc., d/b/a Olympic Bus Lines filed an application (No. D-079302) for an extension of Certificate No. C-992 for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate Motor Vehicles in Furnishing Passenger and Express Service as an Auto Transportation Company (Application). Notice of the Application was published in the Commission's weekly Docket of September 20, 2004.
- The Application request the authority be revised to include passenger service between Port Angeles, Sequim, Discovery Bay, Kingston, Edmonds, Silverdale, and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, and between Port Angeles, Sequim, Discovery Bay, Kingston, Edmonds, Silverdale, and Seattle. No service shall be rendered between Seattle and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, Silverdale and Seattle, and Silverdale and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport.
- The issues in this proceeding include whether the issuance of an extension of authority to Heckman Motors, Inc., for the service it proposes is necessary and is otherwise consistent with the public interest, and whether other carriers are authorized to serve in the territory requested. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under Title 81 RCW, have legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish auto transportation services under chapters 81.68 RCW and 480-30 WAC.

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The statutes involved include those within chapter 81.04 RCW, chapter 81.28 RCW and chapter 81.68 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 81.68.030 and RCW 81.68.040. Rules involved include those within chapters 480-30 WAC and 480-07 WAC.

- The Commission sets a prehearing conference to discuss preliminary matters, the hearing process, and to formulate the issues. Further, a purpose of the prehearing conference is to discuss whether proceedings should be consolidated with Docket No. TC-041340.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That a prehearing conference in this matter will be held at 1:30 p.m., on Thursday, December 16, 2004, in Room 108, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. The prehearing conference will convene at the same time as a prehearing conference in Docket No. TC-041340.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the prehearing conference set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default in accordance with RCW 34.05.440. The parties are further advised that the sanction provisions of WAC 480-07-450 are specifically invoked.
