1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: November 1, 2005.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: January 31, 2005/2006
3. The temporary .80 % fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of August and September 2005, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of November and December 2005.

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services – one month in arrears and the current month:

The surcharge will appear on the December 1, 2005, billing and applies to all services provided in the months of November 2005, and December 2005.
