Amendment Number: 1

Description of amendment:

Amends the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest and Comcast Phone of Washington, LLC by replacing Sections 7.3.4 (Exchange Service EAS/Local) Traffic) and 7.3.6 (ISP-Bound Traffic) with the terms and conditions set forth in Attachment 1 and Exhibit A (attached to the Amendment).

The amendment amends the interconnection agreement first approved by the Commission on February 6, 2004 under WUTC Docket No. UT-033035 (original docket number) and any additional amendments now referenced under Docket No. UT-043126.

Company A represents that the amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers, that it is consistent with state and federal law, and that it is in the public interest. By virtue of Company B's signature on the amendment, Company A believes that Company B agrees with these representations.
