#### **BACKGROUND**

- On September 1, 2006, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) sent a "Notice of Opportunity to Apply for Grant Monies from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund" in Docket TR-051633 to various interested parties eligible to apply for Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) grants.
- On October 16, 2006, the city of Burlington filed an application with the Commission, requesting a disbursement of \$8,100 from the GCPF to pay for a project related to pedestrian safety. On January 4, 2006, the city amended the application to \$6,000.
- The city seeks to install 368 feet of fencing in the area of Lily Lane and Gilkey Road.
- A site visit by Commission Staff in November 2006 confirms the safety problem described by the city and that placement of a fence at this location will significantly reduce access for trespassers to the tracks entering from the west side.

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington having authority to approve and administer disbursements from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund. *RCW* 81.53.271 and *RCW* 81.53.281.
- 6 (2) The project for which disbursement from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund is sought is eligible for funding consideration under Commission rules and complies with the requirements of RCW 81.53.271 and RCW 81.53.281.
- 7 (3) Commission Staff investigated the request based on the review criteria specified in the rules and recommended that it be granted.

8 (4) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 10, 2007.

9 (5) After examination of the application filed by the city of Burlington on October 16, 2006, and giving consideration to all relevant matters and for good cause shown, the Commission grants the request for disbursement of funds.

### ORDER

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- The request of the city of Burlington proposing to install fencing at Lily Lane and Gilkey Road in Burlington, Washington, is granted, subject to the following conditions:
  - (1) Expenditure from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund must not exceed \$6,000.
  - (2) The work for which the Grade Crossing Protective Fund disbursement was approved must conform to the project description specified in the application.
  - (3) Payment will be made upon presentation of claim for reimbursement for costs incurred and verification by Commission Staff that the work has been satisfactorily completed.
  - (4) The project must be completed no later than June 30, 2007.
