SUBJECT: Docket TG-070410; Application for permanent transfer of a portion of authority from G-237 Waste Management of Washington, Inc. to G-260 Torre Refuse and Recycling, LLC.

On February 27, 2007, Torre Refuse and Recycling, LLC, and Waste Management of Washington, Inc., jointly filed application TG-070410 for permanent transfer of a portion of authority to provide solid waste collection services in Spokane County.


The application appeared on the Commission's March 13, 2007 application docket subject to protest for 30 days. No protest or petitions for intervention have been received.


Under the provisions of RCW 81.77.040, any certificate may be sold, assigned, leased, transferred, or inherited as property, but only on authorization by the Commission.

The current certificate G-260 is in order as follows:

- o Financial Services reports the company has paid appropriate regulatory fees.
- o The commission does not have any outstanding penalty or other fine against G-260.
- o Consumer Affairs does not have a pending consumer complaint
- o Transportation Safety does not have a pending compliance action.
- o Since this is only a portion transfer, no closing annual report is required by Waste Management of Washington, Inc.

I recommend the commission grant the portion transfer authority application TV-060575 in Spokane County from Waste Management of Washington, Inc., to Torre Refuse and Recycling, LLC.
