1 On February 4, 2008, CWA, Inc., d/b/a Travel Washington Grape Line, filed an application in accordance with RCW 81.68 and WAC 480-30 for a Certificate to provide passenger transportation service as follows:

PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Walla Walla to Pasco, WA; from Walla Walla, WA over U.S. Highway 12 to Pasco WA, and return over the same route, serving all intermediate points.

NOTE: Intrastate authority is granted consistent with the federal grant of authority under MC-620434 and limited to intrastate operations that are conducted together with regularly scheduled interstate operation on the same route.

2 The commission should issue the requested certificate to provide intrastate regular route service under the provisions of 49 U.S.C.§13902. The intrastate operations are conducted together with regularly scheduled interstate operations over the route authorized by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in MC-620434.

ORDER

3 WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That Application TC-080207, of CWA, Inc., d/b/a Travel Washington Grape Line, is hereby granted, conditioned upon compliance with the laws and rules governing passenger transportation services, and that a certificate be issued to read as follows:

PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Walla Walla to Pasco, WA; from Walla Walla, WA over U.S. Highway 12 to Pasco WA, and return over the same route, serving all intermediate points.

NOTE: Intrastate authority is granted consistent with the federal grant of authority under MC-620434 and limited to intrastate operations that are conducted together with regularly scheduled interstate operation on the same route.
