Dear Allied Waste customer,

This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for King County residential customers in the Allied Waste of Kent areas. Should the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission approve our request customers will experience an overall rate increase throughout all classes of service.

The proposed rate increase is needed because the Company has incurred increased costs, primarily labor and fuel costs. **If approved, the proposed rates will become effective August 1, 2008.**

The proposed rate increases for our residential services range from 0% to 27.11% and not all residential services are listed above.
