MOTION TO RESCIND FINAL ORDER GRANTING, WITH CONDITIONS, A PETITION TO MODIFY; AND CONSOLIDATE FOR HEARING

COMES NOW, City of Lakewood, by and through its attorney(s) of record, and moves the Washington State Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC or "Commission"), pursuant to Washington Administrative Code (WAC) section 480-07-875 to rescind its order in this case and consolidate the Petition to Modify with those currently pending as Dockets TR-100127, TR-100128 and TR-100129. This motion is based on WAC 480-07-320, RCW 81.53.020, the arguments set forth herein and the concurrently submitted Declaration of City of Lakewood City Manager Andrew Neiditz.

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project involves seven highway-rail crossings in the City of Lakewood. All seven are part of a single project and thus involve related issues of law and fact. Separate consideration of a crossing may result in disparity between the modifications at these crossings. The law provides for, and the Commission has ruled in other cases, that where

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separately filed matters "involve related principals of law and fact" consolidation is appropriate.<sup>1</sup> Motions to consolidate or sever may be brought by either party or the Commission on its own motion but discretion as to the decision to consolidate is with the Commission.<sup>2</sup> With regard to the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" crossings, the Commission has consolidated three, which are currently pending as Dockets TR-100127, TR-100128 and TR-100129. The four remaining crossings were processed to final order without hearing based, in part, on a waiver filed by the City of Lakewood.

The Sound Transit "Sounder" project involves four highway-rail crossings in the City of Lakewood. TR-081231, a highway-rail crossing at Bridgeport Way SW in the City of Lakewood, is one of the four expected to facilitate "Sounder" rail service to the City of Lakewood. It is also one of the seven identified for use in the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project. This crossing will be used for both the "Sounder", which the City favors, and the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" which the City opposes. The waiver on file from the City of Lakewood was obtained by WSDOT concurrent with work on the "Sounder" project and at a time when there was little, if any, activity on the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project. At that time WSDOT sought waivers only for those crossings "Sounder" required.

Years later the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project cannot blend waivers into the "Sounder" project because the remaining crossings are not part of the "Sounder" route. The City is opposed to the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" and it is now clear that the four waivers the City signed within the context of the "Sounder" project were to the benefit of the then inactive Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project. Hearings currently pending on the

100129) will impact only the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project. The City believes that the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" project should be reviewed as a whole to ensure consistency in the application of safety concerns. All seven crossings, those for which waivers have been filed and those which are pending hearing, are subject to state law requiring grade separation where practicable.<sup>3</sup>

DECLARATION OF ANDREW NEIDITZ

- I, Andrew Neiditz, declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington:
- 1. That my name is Andrew Neiditz.
- 2. That I am the City Manager for the City of Lakewood, Washington.
- That the City of Lakewood is an Optional Code City operating under the Council-Manager form of government and that, as such, I am the functional equivalent of the Chief Executive Officer of the City.
- 4. That among my duties are to facilitate enhancements to transportation for our citizens, including the "Sounder" rail service anticipated to be establishing service to the citizens of Lakewood within the next several years.
- 5. That "Sounder" service is much delayed from the original expectation and the City has actively pursued ways to expedite the service.
- 6. That, in the course of pursuing "Sounder" service, waivers were signed to facilitate the work necessary to bring "Sounder" service to Lakewood, although on their face, these

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waivers relate to the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) "Point Defiance Bypass" project, a project the City of Lakewood opposes.

- 7. That the "Point Defiance Bypass" project involves adding approximately sixteen new train trips at 79 miles an hour across some of Lakewood's busiest arterials which currently are not active rails.
- 8. That it is the position of the City of Lakewood that the "Sounder" and Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" projects are dramatically different; the "Sounder" enhances the City by providing commuter rail service to our citizens while the Amtrak "Point Defiance Bypass" brings a dramatic increase in train traffic and the related dangers while providing no service to Lakewood citizens since the Amtrak project is designed for high speed service between larger cities.
