Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad has filed petitions with the Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to close three railroad crossings. The crossings are located at:

- North 2nd Street UTC Reference No. TR-110159
- North 5th Street UTC Reference No. TR-110160
- North 10th Street UTC Reference No. TR-110161

Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad also filed a petition to close the North 17th Street crossing in Grays Harbor County. UTC Reference No. TR-110162 is assigned to this petition.
