- On July 30, 2012, in Docket TS-121253, Sean McNamara d/b/a Bellingham Water Taxi (Bellingham Water Taxi) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for an extension of Certificate BC-64619 for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate vessels in furnishing passenger ferry service (Application). Notice of the application was published in the Commission's weekly Docket of August 2, 2012.
- 2 Bellingham Water Taxi requests its existing authority be revised to include passenger and freight service between Bellingham and Friday Harbor, with flag stops at Vendovi and Cypress Islands.
- On August 24, 2012, in Docket TS-121395, Pacific Cruises Northwest, Inc. d/b/a San Juan Cruises (San Juan Cruises) filed with Commission an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate vessels in furnishing passenger-only ferry service between Bellingham and Friday Harbor. Notice of the application was published in the Commission's docket of August 31, 2012.

- 4 San Juan Cruises' application requests authority to provide passenger-only ferry service between Bellingham and Friday Harbor.
- 5 **CONSOLIDATION:** The applications in Dockets TS-121253 and TS-121395 seek overlapping authority, and the latter application was filed within 30 days of the date the former application appeared on the application docket. Because both applicants seek to provide overlapping services, the Commission will consolidate San Juan Cruises' application (Docket TS-121395) with Bellingham Water Taxi's application (TS-121253) for joint consideration, pursuant to WAC 480-51-040(3).
- STATUTORY AUTHORITY: The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under RCW Title 81, and has legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish commercial ferry service under chapter 81.84 RCW and WAC 480-51, including but not limited to RCW 81.84.010, and RCW 81.84.020. The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of RCW 34.05 relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission will also follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.
- 7 The Commission finds there is good cause to hear this matter on shortened notice. See WAC 480-07-440(1)(a).
- 8 THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a prehearing conference in this matter at 10:00 a.m., on November 6, 2012, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S.
