Pacific Power and Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) hereby submits supplemental revisions to Schedule 107—Residential Refrigerator Recycling Program.

On February 28, 2014, the company filed First Revision of Sheet No. 107.1 which inadvertently included references to “Residential” in the tariff. This supplemental filing removes the specific customer class in the description of the tariff. No other changes were made to the previous filing. This filing replaces the Company’s tariff sheet 107.1 filed on February 28, 2014. This filing also provides the Company’s revised tariff index sheet.

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.050 and 80.28.060, WAC 480-107-055 and WAC 480-107-095 and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission’s (Commission) Rules and Regulations, the Company submits for filing a supplemental copy of proposed tariffs applicable to Pacific Power’s electric service in the state of Washington. The Company respectfully requests to keep the proposed effective date of April 1, 2014.

PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY**

Pursuant to Washington Law (including without limitation RCW 80.28.050 and -060) and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Rules & Regulations, Pacific Power & Light Company (Company) has filed with the Commission the original tariff schedules for electric service in the State of Washington.

**Overview**

The Company proposes to modify Schedule 107, residential refrigerator recycle program, to expand the program to include all customer classes. Currently the program is limited only to residential customers. If approved, commercial and industrial customers with qualifying residential refrigerators and freezers would be allowed to participate in the program. The company also proposes to modify the tariff index which references Schedule 107.
