Inc. d/b/a Pierce County Refuse, G-98

Dear Mr. King:

Enclosed please find revised pages for tariff number 9, as well as supporting
documentation for the commodity credit adjustment.

For Pierce County Refuse the credit will decrease from \$1.19 to \$.52 (56.3%) per
residential customer per month. For residential customers on Joint Base Lewis-
McChord, also known as "EQR," the credit will decrease from \$.45 to a debit of \$.08
(117.8%) per unit per month.

If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised
commodity credit will go into effect on March 1, 2016. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-
271(2)(a)(vi), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first
billing reflecting the revised rates.
