## TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 28, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty against Reliance Globalcom Services, Inc. (Company) in the above-referenced docket for failure to submit a complete annual report or pay the regulatory fee. The Commission offered to suspend \$750 of the penalty and then waive it on the conditions that the Company file a complete annual report, pay its regulatory fee, and pay the unsuspended portion of the penalty within 15 days of receiving the Penalty Assessment.

On August 14, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company has not met the conditions, and recommending that the Commission impose the \$750 suspended portion of the penalty.

The Commission has reviewed the record in this docket and accepts Staff's recommendation. The full \$1,000 penalty is now due and payable.
