NOTICE RESCHEDULING SPECIAL PROCEEDING

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties against Tara Chila d/b/a Moves for Seniors*

TO ALL PARTIES:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) initiated a special proceeding in the above-referenced docket to determine if Tara Chila d/b/a Moves for Seniors (Tara Chila or Company) is engaged in business as a household goods carrier without possessing the permit required for such operations.

On August 1, 2017, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Mandatory Appearance at Hearing. On the same date, the Commission issued a *Subpoena and Subpoena Duces Tecum For Production of Documents* (Subpoenas) to the Company commanding Tara Chila to appear before the Commission at a special proceeding scheduled to convene at 9 a.m. on August 23, 2017.

On August 2, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) contacted the presiding Administrative Law Judge and requested the special proceeding be continued until October 25, 2017, to accommodate a scheduling conflict.

The Commission finds good cause to reschedule the special proceeding to **Wednesday, October 25, 2017, at 9 a.m.**

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the special proceeding in this matter is rescheduled to Wednesday, October 25, 2017, beginning at 9 a.m., in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
