RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Airnex Communications, Inc., et al*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 22, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) served a Notice of Intent to Revoke Competitively Classified Telecommunications Company Registration and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) on several telecommunications companies. The Notice informed the companies that, due to failure to submit an annual report and/or failure to pay the required regulatory fee, the Commission would revoke the companies' registration unless they came into compliance within 30 days, or requested a hearing to demonstrate why the Commission should not revoke their registration.

On October 30, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the following companies have all come into compliance:

Cbeyond Communications, LLC
Global Grid Telecom, Inc.
Greenfly Networks, Inc.
Ionex Communications North, Inc.
Modus, Inc.
Washington Telco, LLC

Staff's letter further informed the Commission that the following companies remain out of compliance:

Apptix, Inc.
Business Discount Plan, Inc.
Cytel, Inc.
iNetworks Group, Inc.
IPDATASTREAM, LLC
Reliance Globalcom Services, Inc.

The Commission has reviewed the record in this docket and acknowledges that those companies listed as in compliance will retain their telecommunications registration. Pursuant to the Notice and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-07-905(9), the Commission will enter an order in this docket canceling the registrations of those companies that have failed to come into compliance.
