RE: Docket UE-170952—DO NOT REDOCKET Schedule 137 – Renewable Generation Incentives

Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, submits to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) the following revised tariff sheet in accordance with RCW 80.28.050 and WAC 480-80-122, WAC 480-100-193, and WAC 480-100-028. Pacific Power requests an effective date of October 1, 2017.

On September 11, 2017, Pacific Power submitted Advice 17-07 to introduce Schedule 137, Renewable Generation Incentives. After discussion with Commission staff, the company respectfully requests to add language regarding responsibility to pay customers incentives in compliance with applicable statute. The attached revised Schedule 137, Original Sheet No. 137.1 replaces the same sheet from the September 11, 2017 filing in its entirety. All other tariff sheets from the September 11, 2017 remain unchanged.

In accordance with WAC 480-80-122, Pacific Power requests the Commission allow the tariff changes to become effective with less than statutory notice. Allowing less than statutory notice allows the Company's tariffs to be amended by October 1, 2017, in accordance with Senate Bill 5939.
