Dear Ms. Young:

With the approval of and a grant from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) of \$5,198.65 (Docket TR-180285), the City of Auburn gave authorization for PSE to install the proposed poles and lights.

PSE is onboard with the proposed lighting and estimated cost but has been delayed in getting the Engineering and permits done. They also said they are running into a shortage of LED fixtures in their possession.

PSE is shooting for August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 for construction completion.

The City of Auburn is requesting a 30 DAY extension from the WUTC deadline of August 31, 2018 to complete this project and billing by the deadline.
