RE: Commodity Credit Adjustment for Tariff Number 9, Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Pierce County Refuse, G-98

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Enclosed please find revised pages for tariff number 9, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity credit adjustment.

For Pierce County Refuse the credit will decrease from \$.24 to a debit of \$2.16 (-1,000%) per residential customer per month. This change affects approximately 51,000 customers in Pierce County.

For residential customers on Joint Base Lewis- McChord, also known as "EQR," the credit will decrease from \$.35 to a debit of \$1.90 (-644%) per unit per month. This change affects approximately 4,900 customers on Joint Base Lewis-McChord.

Due to the volatility in the recycling commodity markets we are hereby requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351(2). The calculation uses the most recent six-month historical period to estimate the recycling commodity revenue/commodity credit for the next six months.

We are respectfully asking for relief from the 45 day filing requirement and are filing this filing with less than statutory notice under WAC 480-70-276. If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised commodity credit will go into effect on September 1, 2018.
