On September 6, 2018, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, submitted a new tariff, Schedule 45, Public DC Fast Charger Optional Transitional Rate, and a proposed electric vehicle pilot program, which was docketed as UE-180757. Pacific Power is submitting a revised Sheet No. 45.2 in response to feedback from Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission staff. Pacific Power is revising the new optional transitional rate to require eligible chargers to have more than one DC fast charging standard available. In addition, the revised tariff sheet includes one small correction to a typographical error.
