DG-190058 – Mega D Excavation (603-390-013) – Investigation #7931

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission staff has reviewed the compliance order for Mega D Excavation dated March 13, 2019. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

- \$2,000 penalty for two violations of RCW 19.122 that occurred on January 2, 2018, and September 10, 2018, respectively, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$1,500 of the entire penalty amount if owner and field supervisors of Mega D Excavation attend Dig Safe Training and incur no additional dig law violations within 12 months.

On April 26, 2019, Mega D Excavation notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions, and made a \$500 payment. Staff's review of the compliance conditions determined that Mega D Excavation did not complete Dig Safe training as required by the compliance conditions.

Staff attempted to contact the company, which appears to be permanently closed. The Company's public listings indicate it is no longer in business, and its Washington State Department of Labor & Industries contractor license, which expires May 9, 2020, has not been renewed. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Commission close this docket with no additional action taken.
