RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance D-190239 – JSB Contractors LLC (602-351-040) – Investigation #7938

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission staff has reviewed the compliance order for JSB Contractors LLC (JSB or Company) dated April 16, 2019. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

• \$2,000 penalty for two violations of RCW 19.122, which occurred on February 26, 2018, and October 1, 2018, respectively, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$1,500 of the \$2,000 penalty amount if management and crew foremen of JSB attend Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the penalty assessment, and incur no additional dig law violations within 12 months.

On May 3, 2019, JSB notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions, and made a payment of \$500. On March 11, 2020, two JSB employees attended and completed Dig Safe training. The Company has not had any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes that JSB has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$1,500 penalty amount and close this docket.
