RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Ground Effects Landscaping, in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket DG-190371

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 5, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Ground Effects Landscaping (Ground Effects or Company) in the Amount of \$1,000 for one violation of RCW 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, the penalty subject to the condition that the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On June 17, 2019, the Company notified the Commission that it accepted the condition, and on June 8, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Ground Effects had met the condition. In its letter, Staff recommends the Commission waive the \$1,000 suspended penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that Ground Effects has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$1,000 suspended penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
