Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 22, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Greg's Post Corporation in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(1)(a) for failing to outline a proposed excavation area in white paint prior to providing notice to the state one-call request service. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated September 4, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$1,000 was due by August 4, 2019.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
