Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on October 11, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 01, which assessed a penalty in the amount of \$1,350, \$675 of which was suspended conditioned on the company's compliance with Order 01. The balance of \$675 was due within 10 days of the effective date of the Order. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated December 4, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$675 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$675 balance.
