RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment DG-190884

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on November 22, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against ASP Earthworks, LLC in the amount of \$5,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2) by failing to provide the required notice to facility operators through a one-number locator service not less than two full business days before excavating. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated January 8, 2020, indicating that the balance of \$5,000 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
