TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 19, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Segmental Systems, Inc., (Segmental Systems or Company) for one violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, the penalty subject to the conditions that (1) Company owners complete Dig Safe Training through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the Penalty Assessment; and (2) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On October 20, 2020, the Company notified the Commission that it accepted the conditions.

On January 25, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had submitted a verification of completion for NUCA Dig Safe training and that the Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the Penalty Assessment. In its letter, Staff recommends the Commission waive the \$1,000 suspended penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that Segmental Systems has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$1,000 suspended penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
