1 On November 2, 2020, Asotin Telephone Company, d/b/a TDS Telecom; Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC; Hat Island Telephone Company; Hood Canal Telephone Company Co. - STATUTORY AUTHORITY: The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under Title 80 RCW, and has legal authority to regulate telecommunication companies. The statutes that apply to this matter include Chapters 80.01 RCW, 80.04 RCW, and 80.36 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.01.070, RCW 80.04.110, RCW 80.04.380 and RCW 80.36.080. The rules that apply to this matter include those within Chapters WAC 480-120, relating to telecommunications companies.
- The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of Chapter 34.05 RCW relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission will also follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.
