*** Company proposes to change (Include Title of Provision, Tariff number and Sheets/Pages being changed):**
Recycling (commodity) credit/debits included in Tariff No. 27 pages 21, 25, 28, 29, 30, and 31.

*** Present provisions are:**
Residential single family recycling credit is \$0.40. Multi-family credit is \$0.21. Multi-family 3.5x compacted credit is \$0.74.

*** Proposed changes are:**
Residential single family recycling credit is \$0.09. Multi-family credit is \$0.05. Multi-family 3.5x compacted credit is \$0.18.

*** Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision:**
This is an annual calculation of the recycling commodity credit.

*** Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste):**
As previously allowed per WAC 480-70-271, customer notices were to be included on the affected customer's first affected invoice for the annual recycling credit/debit due to the pass-through nature of the annual commodity adjustment. Kent-Meridian Disposal Co. would like to continue providing similar notice to affected customers.
