In accordance with WAC 480-70-326 this letter serves as the **Transmittal Letter** as required in Section 2.

Description of Change: Effective October 1, 2025, the Residential recycling credit/debit will increase from \$0.72 to \$1.19 and the Multi-Family recycling debit will increase from \$0.34 to \$0.49 due to rising recycling rates set by Whitman County. These adjustments will be reflected in the Commodity Adjustment (Recycle) section of Tariff No. 19, Residential on page 9th Revised page 29 cancels 8th revised page 29 and Multi-Family on page 10th revised page 33 cancels 9th revised page No. 33 of the current tariff.

Change in Revenue: \$0.72 to \$1.19 results in a \$0.47 increase or a 65.28% change for Residential and \$0.34 to \$0.49 results in a \$0.15 increase or a 44.12% change for Multi-Family.
