**Q. Please state your name and business address.**

A. My name is Calvin E. Shirley. My business address is 10885 NE 4th Street, P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue WA 98009-9734.

**Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as Vice President Energy Efficiency Services.

**Q. What are your duties as Vice President of Energy Efficiency Services?**

A. As Vice President Energy Efficiency Services I am responsible for oversight of:  
(i) the Company's portfolio of energy efficiency programs including planning and implementation; (ii) Green Power and Small-Scale Customer Renewable programs; (iii) services to the builder community; and (iv) a variety of customer focused services such as Contractor Referral Services, Personal Energy Advisory Hotline, Hot Water Tank Leasing and Back-Up Generator services.

1 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

2 A. I graduated with a Bachelor's degree from the University of Washington in 1975,  
3 and subsequently pursued some graduate work in Public Administration at the  
4 University of Washington in 1977.

5 I have over 20 years of experience in the utility industry with extensive  
6 experience in energy efficiency program planning, development and  
7 implementation. My experience also includes non-utility employment such as  
8 construction and land use and developing policy and administering programs for  
9 low income populations.

10 From 1977-1978 I worked for the U.S. Department of Energy as Information  
11 Manager working nationally with key energy constituents (nuclear, renewable, oil  
12 producers) concerning federal energy policy.

13 From 1978-1981 I was the Development Manager for the City of Bellevue where  
14 I was responsible for construction and land use approvals. From 1981-1987 I  
15 joined Seattle City Light as the Supervisor of Regulatory Programs with  
16 responsibility for developing energy efficiency policies and requirements for new  
17 and enlarged service connections. From 1987-1993 I served as the Deputy  
18 Director of Human Services for King County with responsibility for the county's  
19 provision of a wide array of programs for low income populations including  
20 weatherization and safety net programs. Between 1995 and 2002 I was employed  
21 at the Snohomish Public Utility District as the Senior Manager of Energy

Services. Responsibilities included management of the utility's energy efficiency programs, major accounts and new product development.
