On May 28, 2020, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities' ("Avista" or "the Company"), filed with the Commission its standard Power Purchase Agreement (PPA), which is an attachment to its tariff Schedule 62 – Qualifying Facilities. Following the Commission's Open Meeting held August 24, 2020 where this filing was discussed, the Company agreed to extend the effective date for when the PPA goes into effect to November 1, 2020. The Company will continue to work with Commission Staff and NIPPC/REC to resolve the outstanding issues discussed during the Open Meeting and will file a revised PPA with applicable changes it can support as soon as reasonably possible.
