5 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

6 A. My name is Cindy L. Song. My business address is 355 110th Avenue NE,
7 Bellevue, Washington 98004.

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

9 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Manager, Business Initiatives.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Manager, Business Initiatives of PSE?**

11 A. As Manager, Business Initiatives, I manage resource additions to PSE’s energy
12 supply portfolio. I lead and coordinate key functions, including negotiations and
13 oversight, in the acquisition or contracting of new energy resources.

14 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

15 A. I graduated from the University of Washington in 2004 with a Bachelor of
16 Science in Finance. I graduated from the University of Texas at Austin with a
17 Master of Business Administration in Finance in 2010. In addition, I am a CFA
18 charterholder.

19 Prior to assuming my current role as Manager, Business Initiatives for PSE in
20 May 2018, I served as a Consulting Financial Analyst, Treasury for PSE from

1 2014 to 2018. In that role, I Initiated and participated in the execution of all
2 capital market transactions. I also assisted the Treasurer in managing relationships
3 with banks and rating agencies.

4 From 2012 to 2014, I served as a Senior Financial Analyst, FP&A for PSE. In that
5 role, I performed quantitative and qualitative analyses related to the production of
6 short-, mid- and long-term financial plans for PSE, created pro-formas and
7 conducted financial analysis to evaluate new business opportunities.

8 Prior to attending business school at the University of Texas at Austin, I was a
9 Financial Analyst, Accounting at Amazon.com. In that role, I prepared journal
10 entries in Oracle financial systems for cash transactions globally, performed
11 monthly reconciliation between general ledger and bank statements, and
12 participated in the preparation of quarterly and annual financial statements.

13 From 2005 to 2007, I was an Associate, Assurance at PricewaterhouseCoopers. In
14 that role, I performed financial statement and internal control audits for various
15 financial institutions. I also performed variance analysis on the financial
16 statement, and created appropriate financial statement adjustments to comply with
17 applicable accounting rules.
