**MEMORANDUM**

- 1 The Commission conducted evidentiary hearings in this proceeding on September 18-21 and 25, 2006. On October 16, 2006, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed its Motion for Leave to File Revised Testimony. PSE specifically proposes to revise oral testimony given by its witness Donald E. Gaines on Tuesday, September 19, 2006.
- 2 PSE proposes to revise Mr. Gaines’s testimony as follows:
  - Transcript page 409, line 19, “\$20.80” should be “\$20.67”.
  - Transcript page 410, line 2, “2 percent” should be “3 percent”.
  - Transcript page 410, line 4, “\$20.80” should be “\$20.67”.
  - Transcript page 410, line 5, “\$21.12” should be “\$20.80”.
- 3 Mr. Gaines’s sworn declaration in support of PSE’s motion states: “In response to Mr. Cedarbaum’s question regarding the price received for the Company’s common stock issuance in November 2005, I stated that we sold stock at \$20.80 per share at a discount of 2 percent.” On review, Mr. Gaines “determined that the Company did not receive \$20.80 per share from Lehman Brothers for its November 2005 common

stock issuance. The Company actually received \$20.67 per share . . . at a 3 percent discount, for a resale price of \$20.80.”

- 4 PSE’s motion is adequately supported by Mr. Gaines’s declaration. No one objected to PSE’s motion.
- 5 The Commission finds that good cause exists to grant PSE’s unopposed motion for leave to revise Mr. Gaines’s testimony. Allowing the revisions will help ensure an accurate record for decision.

**ORDER**

THE COMMISSION ORDERS, that PSE’s Motion for Leave to File Revised Testimony is granted.
