2 ICNU submits this Petition to Intervene pursuant to WAC § 480-07-355.

3 ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric  
customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as  
Attachment A. Many members of ICNU purchase power from PacifiCorp, as indicated  
on Attachment A, and represent some of PacifiCorp's largest customers.

4 ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in PacifiCorp's  
proposed rate increase. The proposed rate change would substantially and directly affect  
those of ICNU's members who purchase power from PacifiCorp. ICNU requests leave to  
intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by the proposed rate  
increase.

5 As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this  
proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be  
affected by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding. It  
is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding. ICNU, therefore,  
requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and make ICNU a party to  
this proceeding.
