WAC §480-07-145(2) (d), NWIGU has provided this Petition by electronic mail. In support of

this Petition to Intervene, NWIGU states the following:

NWIGU is a nonprofit association comprised of thirty-five end-users of natural gas with

major facilities in the states of Washington, Oregon and Idaho. NWIGU members include

diverse industrial interests, including food processing, pulp and paper, wood products, electric

generation, aluminum, steel, chemicals, electronics and aerospace. The association provides an

information service to its members and participates in various regulatory matters that affect

member interests. NWIGU member companies purchase natural gas sales and transportation

services from local distribution companies ("LDCs"), including Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista

Utilities ("Avista" or the "Company").

On April 26, 2007, Avista submitted to the Washington Utilities and Transportation

Commission ("WUTC" or "Commission") a filing requesting a general rate increase for its

natural gas and electric services. Avista's filing proposes a \$4.5 million or 2.3 percent increase

for gas service and a \$51.1 million or 15.8 percent increase for electric service with a requested
