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
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This filing constitutes a general rate change application in which Cascade is seeking to increase its revenues by \$5,743,155 or 3.46% overall. In this filing, Cascade proposes to recover the increased revenue requirement through changes in its rate design and rate spread, based upon results of a Cost of Service Study, which has been included in the filing. Cascade's proposed rates will increase residential rates by 13.7%, commercial rates by 13.5%, large volume firm rates by 2.5% and interruptible rates by 11.5%. The margin (revenues exclusive of gas cost) associated with the distribution system transportation service, Rate Schedule No. 663 is proposed to decrease by 43.3%.
