Parties must bring paper copies of any cross-examination exhibits to the prehearing conference scheduled for the morning of Wednesday, January 4, 2006, or file paper copies of the exhibits with the Commission that same day. All cross-examination exhibits must be in order by witness and must be identified corresponding to identification of the exhibit on the exhibit list. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE PAGINATED AND THREE-HOLE PUNCHED. If the parties wish to present other issues for consideration at the prehearing conference, they must notify the Commission electronically by noon on Tuesday, January 3, 2006. If there are no other issues to be addressed at the prehearing conference, the Commission may cancel the prehearing conference. The Commission will notify the parties by close of business on Tuesday, January 3, 2006, if the conference is canceled. The Commission will provide electronically to all parties by Thursday, January 5, 2006, a master exhibit list assigning numbers to all exhibits and a schedule for the hearing, including all cross-examination time estimates.
