
- 1 On July 5, 2006, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment against LMDS Holdings, Inc. (LMDS Holdings) in the amount of \$100 for a violation of Washington Administrative Code 480-120-382, which requires competitive telecommunications companies to file annual reports with the Commission by May 1 of each year. In the penalty assessment order, the Commission alleged LMDS Holdings failed to file its 2005 annual report by the May 1 deadline.
  
- 2 LMDS Holding was not granted status as a competitive telecommunications company in Washington until January 8, 2006, and therefore was not required to file a 2005 annual report.

**ORDER**

- 3 The Commission rescinds the \$100 penalty issued in the original order in this docket. Staff will revise its records to show there is no amount due from LMDS Holdings, Inc.
