On October 8, 2008, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Granting Accounting Petition (Order 01), in the above reference dockets. Order 01 granted Puget Sound Energy's (Company) request to defer costs incurred in connection with its environmental remediation sites, and required the Company to file quarterly reports for environmental remediation deferrals to include notification of any new remediation sites.
