Dear Judge Hughes:

In furtherance of your request that the parties respond by January 17, 2025 on further scheduling preferences, this is to briefly set forth the positions of the various parties we represent on the current status of the proceedings. First, we have no objection to withdrawal of the E Waste application by DTG under Docket TG-240583. Secondly, we understand the applicant DTG Enterprises, Inc. in Application TG-240584 will be formally requesting that the Commission suspend that proceeding pending resolution of the Complaint filed in Docket No. TG-240761. While, under WAC 480-07-385, we will not necessarily object to the suspension of that proceeding, that would be based on the understanding that for administrative convenience, resource savings and the potential avoidance of duplicate evidentiary showings under WAC 480-07-320, the proceedings would likely be consolidated and the protestants and the intervenor noted below in Docket TG-240584 would be granted the right to participate/intervene in the complaint action should they so elect. With that stipulation/condition, we do not oppose suspension of the application proceeding and schedule in Docket TG-240584 for statewide residuals certificate authority.
